It is important that everyone reading this article knows that this is only a suggestion, yet I *strongly* advise doing the hurricane related research described herein as soon as possible so that you have the official facts and suggestions from Pinellas County. This is an independent choice of your own! *Please do not rely* on any statement provided in this newsletter to protect you or your property during a hurricane or storm.

That said, in last month's newsletter, I duplicated the "Hurricane Evacuation Plan for CCMHP" article from the 2009 newsletter. After it went to print, I learned that for at least part of the summer months, the high school referenced in the article will be closed for renovations.

I also learned that Pinellas County has a *free* and very detailed booklet ("2010 Surviving the Storm" guide) and website (<http://www.pinellascounty.org/emergency/hurricanequide.htm>) devoted to providing citizens with all of the official information and procedures that kick into action should a hurricane warning for our area be issued, as well as many good tips for being prepared in advance. If you don't have access to a computer, *PLEASE* get a printed copy of this guide and keep it handy just in case... It can be obtained at the following locations:
